The senior leadership team together with the school governors would like to update our uniform policy from September 2023 in respect of our polo shirts. #### **Reports**

A reminder for parents / carers to sign and return a copy of their child's end-of-year report. September is fine if you haven't had chance this term!

Breakfast Club will now take place in the mobile building that used to be home to the Reception Class.

This new "home" for Breakfast Club is self-contained with its own kitchen area,

toilets and spaces for children to take part in morning activities.

Children will need to be registered for Breakfast Club in advance - this will help us manage our numbers and know which children to expect on which days. Numbers will be limited to a safe amount in line with the levels of staffing.

If you'd like your child to attend Breakfast Club on a particular day then please drop an email to Mrs Slater giving your child's name and the days of the week you'd like them to attend Breakfast Club. We will confirm places with you at the beginning of

A waiting list will be maintained for any children we cannot accommodate due to numbers, with places offered on a first come/first served basis - so get your email applications sent in quickly!

Children will have to pay £1.50/day towards the cost of Breakfast Club. This will be recorded each day. Children who do not make regular payments will lose their place. If you feel your child should be offered a free place, please include this in your email to Mrs Slater to register a place and we will consider your case and let you know. From September, children will have to be brought to Breakfast Club by an adult - we will no longer accept children who arrive on their own. There will be a sign in system which will require an adult to hand their child over to our care. Breakfast Club will operate from 8am from September, with breakfast served until 8.35am.

Breakfast Club will continue to operate as it currently does for the beginning of September, with the changes outlined above gradually coming into effect over the first half-term. We are not going to make sweeping changes overnight, but I did want


Breakfast Club is undoubtedly an important part of Willaston School. I am told, and have seen for myself, that it provides a vital lifeline to many families in the Willaston School Community.

However, I have also seen for myself that there are some challenges: children arrive through various entrance points, some children pay and some don't, some parents bring their children in whereas some children turn up by themselves. Whilst not wishing to spoil the informal nature of Breakfast Club, I do want to address some of these inconsistencies and make some suggestions which I believe will improve the provision by strengthening our safeguarding, managing our numbers more

effectively and ensuring that we are communicating more effectively our expectations. To that end, from September there will be some changes to Breakfast Club that I'd

to give you the "heads up" that these changes will be phased in from Sept.
