## Maths

### Activities/Games:

- Make your own number story for addition and subtraction (eg, first number 9 was walking in the park, then 3 jumped off, now I have 6).
- Number formation!
- Make lots of 2s, 5s and 10s in sticks and lego etc.
- division/multiplication links
- Use money to make amounts to 10 and 20 - play shops!
- Making 2 digit numbers into lots of 10 and ones eg 2 lots of 10 lego towers and 4 ones = 24.
- Use number cards and play higher or lower.
- Find something longer/shorter than 10 legos or 10 books.

- Make a diary of your day to day life at home and draw a picture. (bring in once school is open again.)
- regularly reading and retelling of stories.
- Using stimulus from 'Once Upon a Picture' or 'Pobble' - write own stories/create own comic strips/videos/diary entries/storymaps.
- Make their videos using toys to create stories.
- Write your own traditional tale!
- Handwriting practise
- Use phonics sound mats to practice letter sounds.

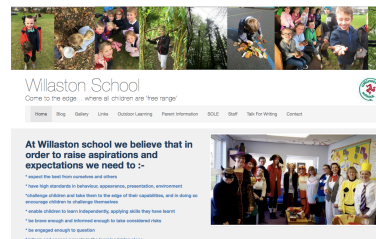

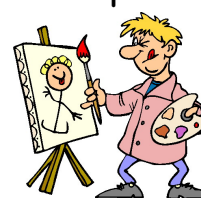
