Maths focus

This week "Me Hearties" we are going to learning about Fractions. A fraction is a part of a whole, a bit like a part part whole model. We are going to start by looking at finding half. I have attached 1 powerpoint about fractions and finding half this week. I would love for you to get hunting and find things in all places, on your walks, in the bath, whilst reading, baking. Whatever you guys get up to! Remember half is 2 equal parts, meaning they are both the same. *Make a concept map of everything you know about finding half! Go on a hunt around your house and garden to find things that you can halve. It might be physical objects, it might be amounts of things, it might by filling something half full. Whatever you can find

MAD ABOUT PLANTS!

In year 1 we loved going out into nature looking at types of plant, where they grow and even growing our own little plants too. We are going to do some more work on plants this half term which will give you an opportunity to explore our island too.

- *Attached is a cut and stick sheet where you can order the sequence of planting a seed. Once you have done this, ask your grown up very politely to see if you can buy some seeds for your self to look after.
- ** I have also attached a flower and plant hunt sheet. Make a tally of how many of each plant you find. I would recommend going to a glen or park to do this.
- ***When you get back can you make a bar chart to show how many of each plant you found. What was the most common?

- * As we know, Pirates loved to sail the 5 oceans? Can you find out what these oceans are called? Can you find them on a map/atlas/globe/google maps?
