### Daily Reading

Ensure your child reads everyday. Check that they are reading accurately and have a clear understanding of what they have read. Ask questions throughout and see what they can recount/remember about what they have been reading.

### Writing Tasks - Fiction:

This week I want you to imagine what happens when Mary leaves THE SECRET GARDEN- Who does she tell ? / How does she describe it ? / Who does she meet/ Does the robin talk to her next time? In your yellow book, in your NEATEST WRITING, write what happens to Mary next . Use lots of wonderful description, capital letters and full stops and don't forget fantastic starters- -ADVERBS, ED STARTERS, TIME CONNECTIVES.  
Use YOU TUBE clips on THE SECRET GARDEN to help you- we will all look forward to seeing the new movie later in the year.

### Maths focus :

This week we are continuing to carry on learning about fractions .... All about tenths - DIVIDING WHOLE INTO TEN EQUAL PARTS - count up and down in tenths -  $1/10$ ,  $2/10$ ,  $3/10$  .....  
Draw a number line - mark it off in ten equal pieces- label it in tenths.  
Use the lesson plan from our school website - Year 3 Week 1 Maths Power point- 3 powerpoint  
Draw tenths in many different ways - PART-PART-WHOLE , BAR MODEL.  
You could choose to watch a fractions " how to " video from YOU TUBE etc
