Daily Reading

Ensure your child reads everyday. Check that they are reading accurately and have a clear understanding of what they have read. Listen to chapter 3 of THE IRON MAN several times this week.

Reading and Writing Task - THE IRON MAN Chapter 3

On the activity sheet there are questions and a story to write to show how well you understand the story.

Maths focus : TIME

We are continuing with learning to tell the time. - WEEK 3 -TELLING THE TIME TO FIVE MINUTES
Use the powerpoint to start and then there are lots of different questions to test your learning.
Get an adult to test you on questions like- What time is it now? What time would it be if the short hand was at.... and the long hand was at..... An analogue clock would be very helpful at this stage to use.

SCIENCE TOPIC- MATERIALS

This week we are returning to our Science learning-I need you to learn what the words on the sheet- SCIENCE VOCABULARY GRID 2 mean- rigid, transparent, flexible etc-you might need to ask an adult to help here. Then I want you to find lots of different objects with these descriptions around your home/ garden and draw/ write their names on the sheet.
See how many different objects you can find for each word.

Ongoing ideas to support your year 3 child :

MATHS :

See how well you can tell the time this week by checking the clock lots of times during the day - can you tell all the different times up to five minutes to/ five minutes past?
