Daily Reading

Ensure your child reads everyday. Check that they are reading accurately and have a clear understanding of what they have read. Ask questions throughout and see what they can recount/remember about what they have been reading.

Writing Tasks - Fiction writing

Find the picture called Morning surprise. Practise your slow writing skills with 5 sentences linked to the picture somehow.

1) Adverb starter e.g. Excitedly, Olly the octopus splashed in the sink. **2) 2Ad sentence** e.g. Olly was a pale-pink, friendly octopus who always spent his Sunday evenings in a small, cramped sink.. **3) Question sentence** e.g. Why did Olly choose a sink, when he could spread out in a bath? **4) Sentence of 3 for action** e.g. Suddenly, Olly splashed water on the floor, flopped out of the sink and scuttled across the kitchen floor. **5) Exclamation sentence** e.g. What a mess!

Write a version of Little Red Riding Hood where the characters of the wolf and Red are switched. The wolf is now the good character who is off on a journey to help someone. Who will your hero be and how will they deal with the baddy- Red?

Maths focus -
