Daily Reading

Writing Tasks - Fiction

Your story can be about any aspect of the war that interests you- the blitz, VE day, life on the front line etc. Please ensure your story has a clear beginning, middle & end and that it contains effective language that engages your reader.

Writing Task - Non fiction

Create a clear set of instructions about how you made your nature home last week.

Some of you have made some lovely bird feeders and bug hotels and we'd love to know what steps you took to make them.

Don't forget to use imperative (bossy) verbs and think carefully about how a set of instructions is usually laid out. Please share on our google classroom!

Maths focus - Division

How many $TO \div O$ division sentences without a remainder can you make with these number cards? Can you beat a family member?



Work through the step-by-step slides to look at dividing with remainders. Can you complete the quiz on Google Classroom? Keep checking Google Classroom for extra challenges.

Explore the two problems about division with remainders. Can you explain it to someone at home?

Topic/Science

This week I discovered the Google Lens app which has helped me to identify plants and insects. It's really easy to use. Ask your adult if you can download it on to a device at home and try it out. You take a photograph of the thing you would like to identify and it brings up some possibilities. I have used it to learn the names of some plants I have at home.
