### Maths focus - Shape & Measure

This week we are focusing on shape, estimating and measuring.

Task 1. Go on a 'house hunt' to find items you **estimate** to weigh 500g and 1000g (1KG) How many can you find?

Task 2. Weigh each item- How close were you?

Task 3. On your next walk outside note down as many different shapes you see and what they were- For example a roundabout would be a circle or a house may be a cube or a cuboid. How many 2D shapes did you spot? How many 3D shapes did you see?

### Topic- Art

Can you create some nature art?

Try to use objects that have fallen on the floor and not pick living things.
