Task 1 - The Mirror of Despair

Task 2 - Be Careful What You Wish For

Read the wishing tale 'One Chance' written by Pie Corbett (on our website/Google Classroom) and have a go at the word and sentence tasks set on the presentation.

Maths focus - Shape & Measure

Task 1. Go on a '3D shape hunt' around your house and make a list- How many different 3D shapes can you find?

Task 2. Make a shape information page, on paper or using ICT- What do you know about both 2D and 3D shapes? Can you remember any of their properties- Faces/Vertices/Edges?

Topic- Science & Geography

What types of pollution affect the natural environment? Use a Thinking Map to record your research. Choose one from the examples on the school website.

Think local. Which pollution affects the Isle of Man the most? What is the Manx community doing to tackle pollution? Remember to share your learning on Google Classroom.

Further task: Choose a pollution and find out what could be done to improve this pollution on our island.

Can you: - write a persuasive letter to the government?

- create a persuasive leaflet or video to inform the community and suggest ways they can help?
