Writing Tasks - Non Fiction

Can you write a newspaper report - reporting the appearance of the Hell Hound on the moors? (from our Hell Hound Text) Remember that a news report needs a great headline, reporting from the past, maybe some key witnesses and quotes from the witnesses. You may want to record yourself reporting the news too! Send the videos to our google classroom.

Maths focus - make sure that you are completing a fluent in five or a timetable quiz often - I have included year 4 & 5 packs to ensure everyone has something they can easily get on with independently.
