English focus - For this final week at home, I thought you could have a go at some work on discussion texts (also known as balanced argument texts!) There is a slide show attached for this and some ideas for you to create your own balanced argument texts. Feel free to choose a discussion topic of your choice, rather than the ideas I have added.

I've attached couple of reading comprehensions to have a go at - my daughters have said that they do quite a lot of these types of activities in year 7 so let me know how you get on - remember to add detail to your answers i.e. not just one word! Remember - PEE - point, evidence, example.

For any further English learning ideas - Pobble is great for story writing and working on your sentence structure.

Maths focus- This week I have set a daily problem solving challenge and activity for you to have a go at. I will post the answers to the challenges on Google Docs the following day. These problem solving activities will ease you into using all four calculation skills again and will make you think about maths in real life contexts.

REMEMBER if you are struggling with these in anyway - please message me and I will help out.

Have a go at completing a fluent in five, a timetable quiz or rapid reasoning daily quiz, several times a week if you can.

Topic - This is your final week of home learning - hopefully! So this week I thought we could focus our learning ideas on the topic of - 'No Place Like Home!'
